b. **2004 Youth Deer Hunt #1107**

The Nevada Wildlife Commission will consider and take action on the 2004 statewide quota to be distributed among groups at the May quota-setting meeting.

c. **Petition – Area 24 Elk Hunt**

The Wildlife Commission will consider a petition to establish an elk hunt in Area 24. The commission will vote to either initiate rule-making action or deny the petition.

d. **Central Nevada Elk Sub-plan**

The Nevada Wildlife Commission will consider the Central Nevada Elk Sub-plan.

e. **Predator Management Plan**

The proposal would add a fiscal year 2004 predator management plan in Elko County to support an on-going research project focusing on sage grouse nest predation.
