STANDARD ENCROACHMENT PERMIT CONDITIONS:

1. Inspections are required. Call 24-hours in advance, (702) 455-4610 or fax 24-hours in advance, (702) 388-2550.

2. Any changes made to the permit by any agency other than Clark County Development Services, will cause the permit to be null and void.

3. The County retains the right to change the right-of-way granted and order the relocation or adjustment of lines, manholes, fixtures, and apparatus hereby allowed to be installed, whenever, in the opinion of the County, this becomes necessary; and desirable and in the event that such an order is made, all changes pursuant thereto shall be made at the sole expense of the Permittee.

4. Proper signs, barriers, barricades, and lights shall be placed and maintained in accordance with the latest "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" as published by the U.S. Department of Commerce.

5. The permit does not authorize closure of any road or street, unless specifically stated on the permit.

6. Call before you dig 1-800-227-2600" for underground service alert.

7. For location of traffic signal interconnect and streetlight conduit call (702) 455-7544.

8. Traffic or street signs of any kind are not to be moved for any reason without first obtaining permission from the Department of Development Services.

9. All work authorized by the permit shall conform to the Uniform Standard Specifications and Standard Drawings Clark County Area,

Nevada[®] and Clark County Supplement to Uniform Standard Drawings and Specification, latest revision[®].

10. No open trench shall be allowed across any street or within ten feet (10') of any travel-way, except when work is in actual progress. Areas covered by acceptable steel plates are not to be construed as trench.

11. A temporary patch is to be in place and is to be maintained by the Permittee. A permanent patch is to be in place within 15 days thereafter.

12. Compaction tests are required.

13. When issued, the permit must be on the job site at all times. All work in the County right-of-way must be completed within the time limit of the permit.

14. It is the contractor's responsibility to maintain a current approved traffic control plan for the work done under this permit.

As applicant for an encroachment permit to do the above described work, I acknowledge that I will be subject to the standard encroachment permit conditions, as stated above, and any special conditions for the restoration of the streets that may be placed on the actual permit for this work in the County right-of-way.
