SUMMARY – An Ordinance to Amend Title 6, Chapter 6.12 of the Clark County Code to Add New Section 6.12.600 to Define the Term “Independent Massage Therapist” and Section 6.12.688 to Define the Term “Massage Therapist”.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 6, CHAPTER 6.12 OF THE CLARK COUNTY CODE TO ADD NEW SECTION 6.12.600 TO DEFINE THE TERM “INDEPENDENT MASSAGE THERAPIST” AND SECTION 6.12.688 TO DEFINE THE TERM “MASSAGE THERAPIST”, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title 6, Chapter 6.12, Section 6.12.600 of the Clark County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.12.600 Independent Massage Therapist/Massage Therapist. Means any person who is self-employed, administers massage as defined in Nevada Statutes 640C, and possesses a valid Nevada State Board of Massage Therapist License.

SECTION 2. Title 6, Chapter 6.12, Section 6.12:688 of the Clark County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.12.688 Massage Therapist. Means any person who works for a massage business or establishment, administers massage as defined in Nevada Statutes 640C, and possesses a valid Nevada State Board of Massage Therapist License.

SECTION 3. If any section of this ordinance or portion thereof is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining parts of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, clauses, phrases or sentences contained in the Clark County Code in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the publication thereof by title only, together with the names of the County Commissioners voting for or against its passage, in a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in Clark County, Nevada, at least once a week for a period of two (2) weeks.
