



EARLY VOTING PROCESS

November 4, 2008 General Election



Overview: The 14-day early voting period for the November 4, 2008, General Election is October 18 (Saturday) to October 31 (Friday). Any voter registered in Clark County may vote before Election Day at any one of the 87 convenient early sites throughout the County. Early voting hours and dates of operation vary by location. Locations include shopping malls, supermarkets, libraries and community centers. Early voting schedules are in sample ballots, newspapers and on the Internet at <http://www.accessclarkcounty.com/elections>.

Voting Machines: All early voting sites will have touch-screen voting machines. The machines include a voter verifiable paper printout of each ballot that stays with the machine. The machines also provide both Spanish and English ballots and instructions.

“Open” General Election: Nevada has “open” general elections. That means you may vote for all offices and questions on the ballot for your precinct, regardless of your party affiliation.

Early Voting Process:

- Upon arriving at the site, your eligibility and signature will be verified before you are allowed to vote. It is always a good idea to bring picture identification with you when you vote. The election clerk will announce your name, as required by Nevada law.
- After verifying your identity, the Clerk will give you a voting machine activation card.
- Computers at each site connect to the Election Department’s centralized voter registration files. Your record is updated at the time of voting, thus preventing anyone from voting twice.
- You will proceed to a voting machine to vote. You must insert the card into the “Edge” to activate it for your specific precinct and party.
- [Nevada Revised Statute 293.270](#) prohibits write-in candidates.
- When you are finished, immediately return the activation card to an election official.
