



ELECTION NIGHT PROCEDURES AND RESULTS REPORTING

November 4, 2008 General Election



PROCEDURES

When: Ballots will be tabulated at the Election Department Warehouse (965 Trade Drive, Suite F, North Las Vegas) after 7:00 p.m., once any lines at polling places have dissipated. Early voting and mail/absentee ballots received before Election Day will be tabulated first.

Where: Set up only in the designated media area within the Warehouse. You may find a map of the interior layout of the Election Warehouse on the Internet at:

ELECTION RESULTS

Formats: After 7:00 p.m. on election night, results will be available to the public in four formats:

- **PC Displays at the Warehouse:** Unofficial results will be displayed on PC's and updated approximately every 20 minutes (*the location of the PC's is on the map of the interior layout of the Warehouse, referenced above*);
- **Hard Copy Summary Reports at the Warehouse:** Hard copy summary reports, containing unofficial result information, will be distributed approximately every 20 minutes in the media area (*the media area is on the map of the interior layout of the Warehouse, referenced above*);
- **Channel 4:** Elections results will be continuously broadcast on Clark County's television Channel 4;
- **Internet:** The summary report containing unofficial election results from early voting and mail/absentee ballots received before Election Day will be the first results available on the Internet after 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. Results updates will be made approximately every 20 minutes. A link to the summary report may be found at:
