



WHAT THE MEDIA MAY EXPECT AT POLLING PLACES AND CENTRAL TABULATION

INTERVIEWS

To arrange an interview, contact Steve Pak at the Election Department at 455-2784.

Interviews may not be conducted inside of a polling place.

POLLING PLACES

Ask for the Team Leader upon entering the voting area. The Team Leader has supervisory authority in the polling place and you should make your presence known to him/her. Team Leaders may ask for your media credentials.

Consult with the Team Leader about filming, photographing, camera placement, lighting, etc.

No one may interfere with the voting process or the work of election staff.

Do not converse with voters in the voting area. Conduct interviews outside of the polling place.

CENTRAL TABULATION SITE AT THE ELECTION WAREHOUSE

Coordinate with the Public Communications Office (Dan Kulin at 455-5534 or 376-3764 or Jennifer Knight at 455-3531) if your organization plans to be at the Election Warehouse on election night. A map helpful for locating the Election Warehouse is available on the Internet at:

Set up only in specific areas designated for media coverage. You may find a map of the interior layout of the Election Warehouse on the Election Department's Internet web site at:

The Warehouse owner does not allow broadcasting antennas on the Warehouse roof.

The public viewing area is where candidates, candidate representatives and members of the public must remain while observing the tabulation process.
