## **NOTICE**

FROM THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE

### **RE: THALIA DONDERO**

The Nevada Supreme Court has ruled that term limit provisions within the Nevada Constitution preclude **Thalia Dondero** from being elected to the office of Regent, State University, District 3. Irrespective of the number of votes Ms. Dondero receives at the 2008 Primary Election, her name will not appear on the ballot for the General Election. At the conclusion of Ms. Dondero's current term of office, the office will be deemed vacant and will be filled by appointment of the Governor.

### **RE: RUTH L. JOHNSON**

The Nevada Supreme Court has ruled that term limit provisions within the Nevada Constitution preclude **Ruth Johnson** from being elected to the office of Clark County School Trustee, District B. In the event that Ms. Johnson places first or second in the Primary Election, the candidate receiving the third highest number of votes will proceed to the General Election.

### **RE: MARY BETH SCOW**

The Nevada Supreme Court has ruled that term limit provisions within the Nevada Constitution preclude **Mary Beth Scow** from being elected to the office of Clark County School Trustee, District A. In the event that Ms. Scow places first or second in the Primary Election, the candidate receiving the third highest number of votes will proceed to the General Election.

### **RE: BRUCE WOODBURY**

The Nevada Supreme Court has ruled that term limit provisions within the Nevada Constitution preclude **Bruce Woodbury** from being elected to the office of Clark County Commission, District A. In the event that Mr. Woodbury receives the most votes at the Primary Election, the Republican Party county central committee will select a nominee to appear on the General Election ballot.
