Training is at a reduced rate (\$40 for Lifeguard or \$60 for WSI certification & LGI certification) for those who sign an employment contract. Positions available from \$9.00 hr. - \$10.50 hr. depending on experience and certifications. Lifeguard Training Classes

Ages 15 years and up

Lifeguard Training Class curriculum includes lifesaving skills, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Automated External Defibrillator and Emergency First Aid. Pre-requisite skills include: 300-yard continuous swim (front crawl and breast stroke) and a retrieval of weighted object from 7-10 feet of water. Class fee for those not interested in employment with Clark County is \$140 and includes book and certification fees (discounted rate of \$40 for those who sign an employment contract). Pre-registration required. All classes must be attended to successfully complete the course. Online registration is not available for this course.

Lifeguard Training Instructor Course

Ages 17 years and up

This course will prepare instructor candidates to teach professional level courses in Lifeguarding, CPR/AED, First Aid, and other aquatics related programs. To receive certification, candidates must pass a pre-course session which includes all basic lifeguard skills, scenarios, and written examinations, attend and participate in all class sessions, and pass final written and skill exams. In addition, instructor candidates are expected to demonstrate maturity and responsibility in all class sessions. Class fee for those not interested in employment with Clark County is \$160 and includes book and certification fees (discounted rate of \$60 for those who sign an employment contract). All classes must be attended to successfully complete the course. Online registration is not available for this course.

Important Health & Safety Requirements

A complete list of pool rules may be obtained at the reception area of each pool. Pool rules are enforced for the public's safety. Additional health and safety rules are as follows:

- Children under 8 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian over the age of 18 at all times. Parent/guardians must be in the water within arms reach of each child.
- All children that wear diapers must wear rubber swim pants or an approved swim diaper in addition to a swimsuit in the pool for health reasons.
- Appropriate swimwear must be worn as required by the Health District.
- Children under 48" tall may not ride the large waterslides.
- During inclement weather or due to other circumstances, the pools may be closed.
- Only Coast Guard approved flotation devices are allowed. Inflatable devices are not permitted.
- Lifeguards' direction must be followed at all times.

Swim Lessons & Programs

NOTE: Please refer to the Aquatics registration form for specific details and registration deadlines and instructions. Classes fill quickly and are registered on a first-come, first-served basis. Clark County is not responsible for lost, misdirected or late/early postmarked mail-in registration.

The department offers American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim classes. Swim classes are provided for youth ages 3 years and older and are skill-level specific. To determine your child's skill level please refer to the class descriptions.

Preschool Swim Lessons

3 – 5 yrs 2 week sessions \$26/session

Students enrolled in this class must be between 3 to 5 years of age. Children should be comfortable entering the water without a parent. Skills involved in this class include: water entry, submerging mouth, nose and eyes, blowing bubbles, opening eyes underwater and retrieving submerged object, floating on front and back with support, swimming on front and back using arm and leg actions, and basic water safety skills. Classes are 30 minutes in length and meet Monday/Wednesday/Friday. After a child completes all required skills of this class and he/she is at least 5 years of age he/she should be placed in Level II. Instructor to participant ratio is 1:6.

Level I Swim Lessons

5 & older 2 week sessions \$26/session

Students enrolled should be at least 5 years old. Skills involved in this class include: water entry, submerging mouth, nose and eyes, opening eyes underwater and retrieving submerged object, floating on front and back with support, gliding, bobbing, swimming on front and back using arm and leg actions with a support, and basic water safety skills. Level I swim lessons are for children 5 & older. Classes are 30 minutes in length and meet Monday/Wednesday/Friday. Instructor to participant ratio is 1:6.

Level II Swim Lessons

5 & older 2 week sessions \$26/session

Students must have passed Level I or Preschool. Skills involved in this class include: water entry, submerging entire head, breath holding, rolling from

front to back and back to front, changing direction of swimming, treading water using arms and legs, swimming on front and back using arm and leg actions without supported, and water safety skills. Level II swim lessons are for children 5 & older. Classes are 45 minutes in length and meet Monday/Wednesday/Friday. Instructor to participant ratio is 1:6.

Level III Swim Lessons

5 & older 2 week sessions \$26/session

Students must have passed level II. Skills involved in this class include: Jumping in from the side, head first entry from sitting and kneeling positions, rotary breathing, treading water, flutter, scissor, dolphin and breaststroke kicks on front, front crawl, elementary backstroke, and aquatic survival skills. Level III swim lessons are for children 5 & older. Classes are 45 minutes in length and meet Monday/Wednesday/Friday. Instructor to participant ratio is 1:6.

Level IV Swim Lessons

5 & older 2 week sessions \$26/session

Students must have passed Level III. Skills involved in this class include: head first entry from stride and compact positions, swimming underwater, feet first surface dive, front crawl and backstroke open turns, treading water using different kicks, front and back crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, butterfly, flutter and dolphin kicks on back, and aquatic survival skills. Level IV swim lessons are for children 5 & older. Classes are 45 minutes in length and meet Monday/Wednesday/Friday. Instructor to participant ratio is 1:10.

Adult Beginner Swim Lessons

14 & older 2 week sessions \$23/session

All adult swim lessons are designed to meet the participant's personal goals. Instructors work with each participant to overcome apprehension and work on basic skills such as floating, swimming underwater, and basic stroke development. Participants must be 14 & older. Classes are 45 minutes in length and meet twice per week. Instructor to participant ratio is 1:10.

Adult Intermediate/Advanced Swim Lessons

14 & older 2 week sessions \$23/session

Designed for adults and teens with basic water experience such as floating, swimming underwater, and basic stroke development. Instructors will work with each participant on stroke work including front and back crawl, breaststroke and butterfly. Participants must be 14 & older. Classes are 45 minutes in length and meet twice per week. Instructor to participant ratio is 1:10.

Specialized Swim Programs

Swim Team

6 & older 6 week session \$45/session

This is a recreational level swim team program that encourages teamwork and self-esteem. Participants will practice four times per week to develop strokes and improve personal times and skills. Emphasis is on personal improvement. Pre-requisite: participants must be able to swim 25 yards of the pool independently using an over-arm stroke with rhythmic breathing. It is highly recommended that the participant complete Level IV Swim Lessons before enrolling. Program fee includes instructional practices and swim meets.

Synchronized Swim Team

6 & older 6 week session \$45/session

Participants will learn the fundamentals of synchronized swimming, which blends creative movement and dance in the water. Pre-requisite: participants must have a minimum of Level III swim skills. Program fee includes instructional practices and synchronized swim meets.

Water Exercise Programs

14 & older

6 week sessions

*With all water exercise programs, please notify your instructor if you have any health concerns, previous injuries or medical conditions that may be aggravated during workouts.

Arthritis Foundation Aqua Class

This class is designed for participants with arthritis or joint problems. It involves a variety of movements to assist participants improve mobility, flexibility, balance, coordination and posture. This is a low impact class; the ability to swim is not required.

Low Endurance

This class is designed for participants to actively move through the water using their whole body by kicking, moderate bouncing, jogging, walking and stretching. It is not a fast aerobic class, therefore heart rates will be average to moderate. Participants should work at their own pace and let the instructor know of any problems. Ability to swim is not required.

High Endurance

This class is designed for the more physically fit person. It involves more movements at a faster pace. Some movements included are jumping jacks, high kicks, fast jogging, abdominal work, and water weight toning with barbells. Participants should work at their own pace and let the instructor know of any problems. Ability to swim is not required.

Mixed Endurance and Toning

This class uses a variety of buoyancy equipment to tone and shape your muscles while building strength and cardio vascular endurance. This class can be done in both deep and shallow water. Ability to swim not required.

Master's Swim Program

18 & older

Monthly

This is a co-sponsored program with the Las Vegas Master's Group; Victor Hecker is the head coach. The program consists of organized competitive and recreational level swimming for adults. It helps participants keep in shape, improve strokes or prepare for a triathlon. Practices held at Desert Breeze Indoor Pool.

Drowning Prevention Information

Death and injuries

- A swimming pool is 14 times more likely than a motor vehicle to be involved in the death of a child age 4 and under
- Each year, approximately 1,150 children ages 14 and under are hospitalized due to near-drownings
- Of children surviving near-drownings, 5-20% suffer severe and permanent disability

Where Drownings Happen

- Approximately 50% of preschool aged drownings occur in residential swimming pools
- Each year, more than 2,000 preschool aged near-drownings occur in residential pools
- Each year, 350 drownings (for all ages) happen in bathtubs
- Each year, approximately 40 children drown in five-gallon buckets
- Nevada is one of the 10 states in the US where drowning surpasses all other causes of death for children aged 14 and under

How and When Drownings Happen

- Of all preschool aged children who drown, 70% are in the care of one or both of their parents at the time of drowning
- Of all preschool aged children who drown, 75% are missing from sight for five minutes or less

Parent Drowning Prevention Tips

- Never leave a child alone near a pool, spa, bathtub, toilet, water-filled bucket, pond or any standing body of water

- There is no substitute for adult supervision, make sure an able adult is constantly watching
- Drownings and near-drownings occur in familiar surroundings during very short lapses in supervision, such as leaving to answer the phone or the doorbell
- If you must leave the area, take your child with you
- Do not have older siblings watch younger children in the water as they are often not trained or mature enough to handle the responsibility
- Do not rely solely on swimming lessons, life preservers, or any other equipment that makes your child "water safe"—these only minimize risk, they are not foolproof
- A fence or wall barrier should completely enclose your pool or spa
- All gates or doors leading to the pool area should have a self-closing and self-latching mechanism that protects against unauthorized entry and use
- It is recommended that homes with pools have alarms on windows and doors to notify you if someone leaves the house to enter the pool area
- Do not place objects near the pool or spa fence that could allow a child to climb over
- Do not leave toys or objects in the pool area that will attract your child, put them away out of sight
- Learn to swim
- Never swim alone, always swim with a buddy
- Take a CPR and First Aid course and keep emergency phone numbers and a portable phone poolside
- Check the pool area first if a child goes missing
- Constant adult supervision is essential!
