ABOUT THE POSITION:

This position will perform camp facility maintenance to include cleaning bathrooms, toilets, counters, walls and mopping floors; maintain and perform repair work on a variety of park and camp facilities and equipment; may paint facilities, assist with plumbing, carpentry work, concrete and roof repair; perform routine maintenance and repair work on camps two generators; observe safe work methods and use safety equipment; secure work sites from the public; carry out assignments in a non-disruptive manner in areas receiving heavy public use; operate and maintain a variety of hand and power tools and equipment, including tractors, chainsaws, rakes, shovels, hoes, brooms and other tools; operate trucks, trailers and tractors with attachments; uses snow blowers and snow removal equipment; install, repair and maintain plumbing systems; operate camps water well pumping equipment and distribution system; clean and maintain campgrounds, picnic areas, playground, basketball courts, amphitheater and trail system; contribute to the efficiency and effectiveness of the staffs' service to its customers by offering suggestions and directing or participating as an active member of a work team; work in an environment with public interaction and help accommodate camp rental groups; check rental groups in and out as well as give rental groups an orientation to the camp and forest environment; and notify groups of camp rules and regulations as well as give tours to future rental groups. Part-time employment will not lead to permanent employment. Part-time employees do not receive benefits.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Education and Experience: Must have at least six months experience in a related maintenance position.

Preferred Qualifications: Strength and mobility to work in a typical park maintenance setting. Must be able to tolerate extremely cold weather and work for extended time in an outdoor setting.
