## ***Paradise's RecTrek is a Year-Round Affair*** Recreation Center Offers Fun, Safe Day Camp for Kids

School track breaks can oftentimes be a headache for parents who worry about where their kids are playing, who they are hanging out with and if they are being safe. Paradise Recreation Center's RecTrek program can soothe the worried minds of parents during those breaks while providing a safe place for kids to create, explore and make new friends.

RecTrek is a year-round program for children ages 6 to 12 and keeps them busy Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. during track and school breaks at Paradise Recreation Center, 4775 McLeod Drive, near Eastern and Tropicana avenues in southeast Las Vegas. Cost for the camp is \$15 per day or \$70 per week, per child. There is a 50 percent discount for the third child if enrolling three children from the same family for the entire week. Financial assistance may be available for those who qualify through the Equal Opportunity Board (EOB).

Participants in RecTrek enjoy field day activities, guest speakers, themed days, playground free time, arts and crafts activities, cooperative sports, drama and movies.
