Camp Concludes with Circus Extravaganza Winchester Players Presents 'It's Entertainment' Aug. 14-15

Winchester Cultural Center's Theater Boot Camp upped the ante this summer with magic, circus and creative writing added to its traditional list of dance and drama skills. The summer camp concludes with "It's Entertainment," a culmination of a summer's work, at 7 p.m. Aug. 14 and 15 at the Winchester Cultural Center Theater, 3130 S. McLeod Drive. All tickets are \$5.

The show is a musical journey through dance, rock n' roll and magic, where the audience participates in the laughs and fun as the children run off to the circus. Campers ages 6 to 17 have been in rehearsal since June in preparation for the show, which features elements of tap, jazz and ballet mixed in with musical theater, magic and circus performances.

The Theater Boot Camp is lead by Winchester Players director Susan Swanson and by her brother Christopher Swanson. Susan Swanson brings Broadway experience from shows such as "No, No Nannette," "Pajama Game" and "Anything Goes" while Christopher Swanson was a long-time performer in "Jubilee!" at Bally's on the Strip.

The fun and skills campers learned this summer can continue with the fall session of the Winchester Players. The 12-week session begins Sept. 29 with classes for ages 9 to 17 from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesdays and ages 6 to 8 from 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Wednesdays. Price for the class is \$90 for ages 9 to 17 and \$80 for ages 6 to 8. The price of the class includes two tickets per child to the show in December.
