Bite of Las Vegas Returns for 12th Year Lifhouse to Headline Festival Oct. 18 at Desert Breeze Park

Clark County Parks and Recreation, in partnership with Mix 94.1 FM and Wells Fargo, present the 12th annual Bite of Las Vegas food and music festival from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Oct. 18 at Desert Breeze Park, 8275 Spring Mountain Road at Durango Drive. Admission is \$8 for adults and free for children ages 5 and younger. Attendees can receive \$1 off the admission price with a donation at the gate of canned food for the City Mission of Las Vegas. Additionally, \$1 of every ticket sold also will be donated to the City Mission to help feed the hungry in Las Vegas.

Bite of Las Vegas is Nevada's largest food and music festival and features 45 Las Vegas restaurants in one place. Menu selections include barbecue, Mexican, Asian, French, Mediterranean, Italian, pizza, gourmet sandwiches, kids' selections and desserts offered in \$1 to \$5 portions. Bite of Las Vegas restaurants also compete for the best-decorated booth as well as in nine different Best Bite categories judged by The Culinary Institute of Las Vegas.

Additional entertainment will include the kids' area with carnival rides and games, and cooking demonstrations by professional chefs will be performed all day on The Culinary Institute Cooking Stage.
