House of Blues Educates Youth in Music Percussion Program Begins Sept. 20

Clark County Parks and Recreation and the International House of Blues Foundation present the Make an Impression Drum Initiative program for the third year at Winchester Cultural Center. Two classes are offered at 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. on Saturdays beginning Sept. 20 and continuing through April when students will have the opportunity to play a recital at the House of Blues located inside Mandalay Bay. Classes take place at the Winchester Cultural Center, 3130 S. McLeod Drive. Cost for the program is \$30.

The Make an Impression Drum Initiative program, led by experienced musician Robert Shipley, offers lessons to students who otherwise wouldn't have the chance to learn percussion skills. The program steps in when the lack of musical instruments and funding is apparent.

The national program is sponsored by the International House of Blues Foundation, Washburn International, a leading guitar manufacturer; Drum Workshop Inc., Pro-Mark Corp., Sabian Cymbals and Clark County Parks and Recreation.

The class is geared to beginners, ages 10 to adult, who have never before participated in this program. Space is limited.
