Junior Triathlon Challenges Valley Youth Children ages 6 to 13 Must Register By Sept. 22 to Qualify

Clark County Parks and Recreation's Junior Triathlon will test the endurance of the valley's youth for the third year on Sept. 27 at Desert Breeze Pool, 8275 Spring Mountain Road at Durango Drive. The traditional triathlon is designed for children ages 6 to 13 and challenges them to swim, bike and run to the finish line. All age groups must check in at 8 a.m. with the first race beginning at 9 a.m. **All participants must pre-register by Sept. 22 to qualify.**

Participants are divided into categories by the following age groups:

- Ages 6 to 7 will participate in a 50-yard swim, 1-mile bike ride and half-mile run;
- Ages 8 to 9 will swim for 75 yards, bike for 1 mile and complete a .7-mile run; and
- Ages 10 to 11 will complete a 100-yard swim, 1.75-mile bike ride and 1-mile run with ages 12 to 13 swimming for 200 yards, biking for 1.75 miles and running for 1 mile.

Registration is available in person at the Desert Breeze Pool or online at www.accessclarkcounty.com/parks. All participants will receive a race bag, T-shirt and a finisher medal. Those interested can call 455-7798, and press option 2 for additional information.
