>> RIGHT, IF THEY ARE PURELY PROCEDURAL ITEMS, YOU CAN.

>> MADAM CHAIR.

>> COMMISSIONER WOODBURY.

>> I'M DISCLOSING THAT OUR LAW FIRM HAS AN ATTORNEY/CLIENT RELATIONSHIP AND REPRESENTS THE APPLICANT IN MOST CASES BUT NOT ON THESE ISSUES. 61, 124, 219 THROUGH 222, 298 THROUGH 294 AND 311 THROUGH 341. A LOT OF THESE ARE THE VERY SAME BUSINESS BUT HAVE -- DIFFERENT AGENDA ITEMS BUT I'M ALSO INFORMED BECAUSE THESE ARE PROCEDURAL THAT I CAN GO AHEAD AND VOTE. IS THAT CORRECT?

>> THANK YOU, BACK TO 381, UNITED COIN MACHINE, DOING BUSINESS AS THE 7-ELEVEN STORE 28656C AT 4510 VEGAS VALLEY DRIVE, THE APPLICANT, A LICENSED SLOT OPERATOR SEEKS APPROVAL FOR A CLASS A SLOT MACHINE LICENSE. A PUBLIC HEARING IS REQUIRED, DISTANCE TO A SCHOOL.

>> ROB WOODSON, UNITED COIN MACHINE COMPANY.

>> WE'LL OPEN UP THE PUBLIC HEARING AND ASK IF THERE IS ANYONE IN THE AUDIENCE WISHING TO BE HEARD ON THIS ITEM? TURN IT OVER TO THE BOARD.

>> THANK YOU. ITEM 382, WAL-MART STORES I THINK DOING BUSINESS AT WAL-MART SUPERCENTER AT STORE 3350 AT 5198 BOULDER HIGHWAY. THE APPLICANTS SEEKS APPROVAL FOR A PACKAGED LIQUOR AND PACKAGE BEER, WINE, AND SPIRIT BASED PRODUCTS IN CONJUNCTION WITH A GROCERY AND DETERMINATION OF SUITABILITY AS OFFICERS AND DIRECTOR. THIS PUBLIC HEARING IS DISTANCE TO CHURCHES.

>> ARE YOU THE APPLICANT ON THIS ITEM?

>> YES, I AM, GOOD MORNING. STEVEN SCHWARTZ, I'M THE KEY ASSOCIATE FOR WAL-MART, 5198 BOULDER HIGHWAY.

>> AND YOU, SIR?

>> PASTOR DAVID BROWN, DESERT HILLS CHURCH ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE WAL-MART.

>> ALL RIGHT, I WILL OPEN UP THE PUBLIC HEARING. WOULD YOU LIKE TO SPEAK?

>> YES, WE ARE LOCATED AT 4431 SOUTH NELLIS AND THE CHURCH HAS BEEN THERE 40 PLUS YEARS. I, AS PASTOR, HAVE BEEN THERE 21 YEARS. WE WERE DELIGHTED WHEN WE HEARD THAT WAL-MART WAS MOVING IN. WE NEEDED THAT IN OUR COMMUNITY. THE COMMUNITY HAS BEEN DETERIORATING. IN THE PAST TEN YEARS, RAPIDLY. AND WE NEEDED SOMETHING LIKE THAT. SO WE WERE EXCITED. WE WERE NOT CONTACTED PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION ABOUT LIQUOR BEING SOLD. AND WE DO HAVE A PROBLEM WITH A HIGH TRANSIENT RATE OFF OF BOULDER HIGHWAY AND FROM SAM'S TOWN. LIQUOR IS AVAILABLE IN EVERY DIRECTION, BOTH PACKAGED LIQUOR AND BY THE DRINK. SO THEY BUY THAT, AND THIS COME OVER TO THE CHURCH PROPERTY AND DRINK IT. BEHIND US IS A PUBLIC PARK THAT THEY TRY TO GO THERE AND DRINK IT. THEY ARE RUN OUT BY THE PARK POLICE AND SO THEY COME TO THE CHURCH TO DO IT. SO I BELIEVE THAT IT WOULD JUST ADD TO THE DETERIORATION OF THE COMMUNITY IMAGE AND, ALSO, IS A GREAT NEGATIVE TO THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE THAT WE HOST PERIODICALLY IN MEETINGS AND SO ON. SO I THANK YOU FOR THIS OPPORTUNITY.

>> IS THERE ANYONE ELSE WISHING TO SPEAK ON THIS ITEM? ALL RIGHT, IF NOT, COMMENTS THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO ADD BEFORE WE TURN IT OVER TO THE BOARD?

>> WELL, BY PASTOR BROWN'S OWN AD VISION, THERE IS LIQUOR AVAILABLE EVERYWHERE IN THE VICINITY AND THERE IS AN ORDINANCE THAT YOU CAN'T CONSUME LIQUOR WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF ANY PLACE THAT SELLS IT. WE HAVE A GREAT RELATIONSHIP WITH METRO AND WITH THEIR CLOSE PROXIMITY TO US THEY CAN ENFORCE THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL WITHIN A THOUSAND FEET OF OUR PROPERTY ONCE WE SELL ALCOHOL.

>> I'LL TURN IT OVER TO THE BOARD.

>> MADAM CHAIR.

>> COMMISSIONER.

>> THANK YOU. I APPRECIATE THE COMMENTS. I DON'T KNOW THAT WE HAVE EVER DENIED A CONVENIENCE STORE OF A SHOPPING CENTER OR A GROCERY STORE A LIQUOR LICENSE. AT LEAST THAT I'M AWARE OF. HAVE WE DONE IT IN THE PAST?

>> I WILL START TO ANSWER THAT. NOT THAT I KNOW OF. IT IS FAIRLY CUSTOMARY FOR WAL-MART STORES AND OTHER GROCERY STORES TO HAVE A LICENSE FOR THE PACKAGED LIQUOR, AND THE PACKAGED WINE AND SPIRIT-BASED PRODUCTS.

>> RIGHT. YOU KNOW WHAT WE'VE HAD CONCERNS ABOUT HAVING A TAVERN OR SOMEONE WHO IS CONSUMING ON THE PREMISES OR IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO A CHURCH, A SCHOOL OR A PLAYGROUND, WE GIVE THAT STRONG CONSIDERATION. I APPRECIATE YOUR CONCERN. I DON'T DRINK MYSELF, BUT MANY OTHERS DO AND THEY MAKE THAT CHOICE. I DON'T THINK THAT THIS RETAILER IS ANY DIFFERENT THAN ANY OTHER RETAILERS WITH REGARD TO THE SELLING OF ALCOHOL. THEY DON'T ALLOW CONSUMPTION ON THE PROPERTY AND THIS IS SOMETHING WE LOOK TO METRO WITH IN ENFORCING THIS. I DON'T KNOW THAT IT'S BEEN AN ISSUE. IF THERE ARE NO OTHER COMMENTS OR QUESTIONS, I'M GOING TO MOVE APPROVAL.
