Clark County Parks and Recreation offers four different, six day summer resident camps at Camp Lee Canyon in the Toiyabe National Forest. All camps begin on Sunday and end Friday evening. Each camp has a special focus and is geared toward a specific age group. Campers will also enjoy traditional camp activities such as hiking, campfires, skits, and games.

Camp Lee Canyon is located in the Spring Mountain Range, 45 miles from Las Vegas. Cool mountain air, rustic cabins, and the natural beauty of this alpine setting provide an excellent atmosphere for learning, relaxation and fun.

Campers stay in group cabins supervised by trained counselors. Other in-residence staff includes instructors, a registered nurse, a camp director, and a camp manager. Professional caterers provide meals. All meals, a daily snack, class supplies and a camp T-shirt are included in the camp fee.

Participants are required to bring their own bedding (sleeping bags or sheets and a blanket) and suitable clothing. A packing list and information packet with map will be provided prior to camp. Parents or guardians are responsible for camper's transportation to and from camp.

Camp Bristlecone is a group experience that maintains a 4 to 1 participant to staff ratio; we are unable to provide one on one assistance while at camp.
